A recent Gallup Management Journal's Employee Engagement Index poll found that only 29% of employees are actively engaged in their jobs, 54% are not engaged, and 17% are actively disengaged. These startling statistics mean that supervisors and managers have to become skilled in engaging and retaining a talented, diverse, and high-performing staff. You need connected and committed employees to successfully advance the organization's mission and goals.

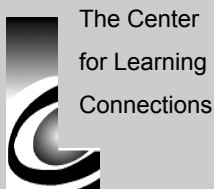
